Can we write prayers for all of the people who are helping and caring for the needy, sick and old?

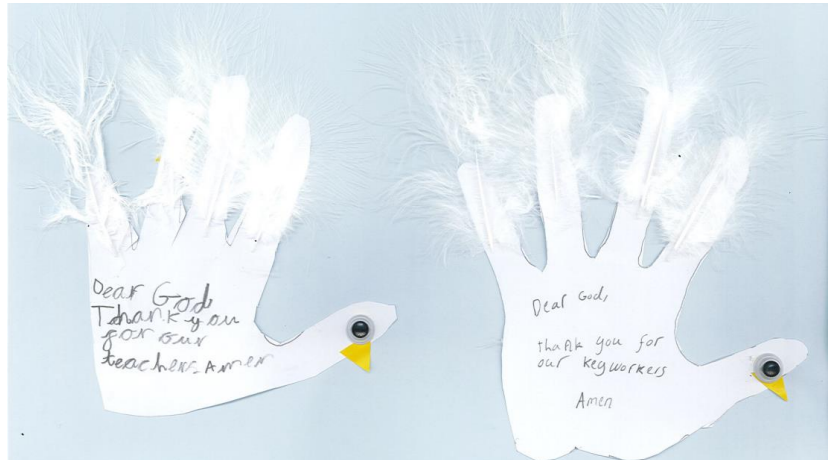

Coin Snatching

THE RULES

1. The coins are to be placed on the elbow.
2. All coins must be caught in one snatch and the snatch is to be achieved on a downward beat of the same arm and the coins caught palm down. If not all of the coins which are stacked are caught, the attempt is still valid, but only those which are caught would count.
3. Once they are ready on the elbow, the coins are not to be touched by the hand which is not being used to catch them.
4. No adhesive of any sort may be used.
5. The coins to be used are 10p coins.
6. How many can you snatch perfectly?
